Mister Prime Minister,

We notice that there was pursue in the practices from the prior government, ie ignoring the Scientific Research branch in the Program of Government, as an independent area, the absence of answer to the notifications submitted to the government members, You included, ignoring the information on robbery from the European funds, including their detour, particularly those meant for the Scientific Research and these actions materialised into effectively destruction of the domain, as stipulated by art 5 of the GEO 96/2012.

For supporting the above allegations on the consequences on the destruction of the National Authority for Scientific Research and their replacement with a minister delegate for the higher education, Scientific Research and Technological Development, the ministry name has become the Ministry for National Education, in doing so breaching art 1(5) and art 135(2c) of the Romanian Constitution. Firstly, we notice the domain is assimilated to the education, which also can be found in the government program, then the cancellation of the Scientific Research and Technological Development domain, and the implementation of the provisions of the aberrant Law 1/2011 for our branch, that the respective law had included into the higher education.

The adoption of the GEO 96/2012 and the consequences of the art 5 provisions lead to the disappearance of the last possibility for a social dialogue for the domain, and effectively it removes the Romanian scientific research and technological development from the European framework, by the lack an autonomous government structure, correlated to the European

Commission ones, and being responsible with the implementation of the specific European regulations and strategy – European Researcher's Charter and European Research Area. For the scientific research only, we had a minister delegate during 2000-2002, but he was for a selfstanding structure, so that, when the position had been restructured, the domain did not disappear. The National Authority for Scientific Research showed up as result of Prime Minister's Adrian Nastase initiative, regulated by the GD 2200/2004 on the restructure of the National Agency for Science, Technology, and Innovation, and in order to allow the possibility to establish the Ministry for Scientific Research and Technology, as a result of the irregularities and disinformation on the branch from Ecaterina Andronescu and after consultation had with our federation - F.S.L.C.P.R.. The project had been stopped by the university clientele group mischiefs: Ecaterina Andronescu, Anton Anton, A.Marga, M.Miclea, and with the help received from the President Traian Băsescu, who blocked the Social Democratic Party from appointing the government according to the election results. The university clientele detour of the budgetary and European funds by preventing the publishing of the GD 2200/2004 into the Official Journal and the inclusion of the National Authority for Scientific Research as structure of the Ministry for Education, Research, Youth, and Sports, comprising also the cancelation of the independent budget chapter (at that time we had the same regime as the Romanian Academy), considering the doctorate work as scientific research and using them for blackmail, as well as granting scientific titles (prosperous business after the one for licence diplomas) and many others, all that reached a peak with the provisions regarding the area (aberrant, and creation of the same Ecaterina Andronescu) from Law 1/2011. They even got to the creation of an obedient trade union structure (to see F.N.S. Alma Mater, led by A. Hadăr, "colleague" with Tudor Prisecaru), to buying some important trade union leaders (who asked and sustained the necessity to destroy the field of activity) by projects funded from European funds (to see the case of D. Costin and Daniel Funeriu's statements at C.M. POSDRU). At their turn, the above mentioned "funded" from these funds "influent" persons such as, for instance, Virgil Voineag (who presented false figures and manipulated also the CE investigations on our branch) and Liviu Voinea or some others supposed to represent the civil society (Ad Astra society, that also delivered the last positions holders for Daniel Funeriu and Dragos Ciuparu). The lack of reaction makes the above mentioned to proceed their actions in the same way (to see: at the Univ. Vasile Goldis, the person in charge with the scientific research on European programs is Funeriu's father, or the

Catalogue of the funding sources – Centre region – programs for the universities). There are documents submitted to the National Anti-corruption Directorate on the activity of some above mentioned, due to their invitation there as result to the public statements and media releases we had made, but I was informed that the investigation has been suspended. The involvement and the complicity at the top levels is obvious, a clear example in this regard being even the ELI-NP project, with the new-comers quickly integrated into the clientele structure, such as N. Zamfir (quick ascension and important contribution in destroying some research equipment of national interest, harassment, etc together with their accomplices in the crockery). You have been informed about most of the above statements in the submitted documents (and also in a personal letter), both as U.S.L. co-president (also letter sent to Crin Antonescu), and as prime minister where I inform you upon few of the most important facts, and which I haven't received a reply yet: Note with no 16 /08.02.2012, registered at P.S.D. with no 72 /09.03.2012; no 26 /09.05.2012, registered at the Government with no 7165/14.05.2012; no 64 /23.08.2012, registered at the Government with no 13139/23.08.2012, to which I can add the letters sent by C.S.D.R. on the signalised issues.

We draw once again the attention that the adopted measure pursues and accomplished the policy for destruction of the Scientific Research – the Technological Development of Romania, initiated by the trans-party university mafia and implemented by Boc government, including by eliminating the specific field of activity, with the obvious purpose to cover up the frauds with European funds and from the estate budget (during all this time not once there had been a time where the approved budget for Scientific Research had not been reduced during its execution), by taking over the assets of the scientific research institutes, totally despising the national interest, and this without mentioning the European policies in the area.

With confidence and availability for clarifying the situation, and in order to stop the current trend to destroy the Scientific Research – Technological Development of Romania,
