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Opinion on the Misinformation from the 2013 "SOCIAL TRENDS ", published by the National Institute of Statistics

Under its new leadership, the analysis of the data from the 2013 “SOCIAL TRENDS” issued by the NIS continues the misinformation on the Scientific Research – Technological Development of Romania started some time ago. Consequently:

1- it cannot be accepted that, on page 39, paragraph of the Chapter on Education, the title of a ministry to be put in total opposition with the government structure – the Ministry of Education, Research, Innovation and Sports (actually it was the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sports, and from 2012 it is the Ministry of National Education), and this to be done in a document issued by the National Institute of Statistics.

2 – In the same chapter EDUCATION, the Scientific Research – Technological Development is “sent away”, the area having no connection with the subject of the text, as it is not part of the Higher Education, as it results from the title of the chapter, but also from the European Regulations – I mean the Researcher’s European Charter, and the Researcher’ Recruitment Code of Conduct, but also as shown in the regulations adopted during the Bologna Process. To read at page 40, the paragraph “*correlation between the education and the research, development and innovation systems with the European goals and landmarks*” and “*increase the quality of education and research in training the creative human resources*”.

3 – the not at all ambiguities with regard to the higher education continue by introducing some categories like “*higher secondary education*”, some specializations like “*faculties with specializations in the university area*” which are not to be found in the wording. As for the performances, they keep on the procedures before 1989, and after their exacerbation by carefully chosen reportings, which it is obvious are not so good, as it results from the presentations on pages 41, 47, 48.

4 – likewise the falsification of the European questionnaire on doctors’ and research staff’s mobility, by omitting some negations in the Romanian version, the research units and institutes are eliminated as potential workplaces, leaving only the university option, fact which we signaled both to the NSI, and to the IMF delegation, to the EC, to the World Bank, and to the government at the time. We told them about the credibility on the data given by the so-called institute, without any ulterior consequences, and now the SR-TD disappears as field of activity. It is an assumed transposition on the interpretation of the Law no 1/ 2011, corroborated with the change of the activity fields by the GD. 1260 / 2011, proving the university clientele involvement that coordinated the destruction of the area, at this level, too.

5 – according to the information we have, this publication does nothing else but to confirm the facts

we have proven on the existence and the size of the university mafia, on the detour, as result to the EU policies and to 2020 Europe Strategy, made by its representatives at all levels of the European funds allowed for the SR-TD to their structures, including by statistics. The European documents and policies are ignored or adapted (translated with omissions) in order to serve the clientele interests, practice that still goes on even after the removal of Mr Vergil Voineagu, which happened when his practices went in opposition with the government interests. It did not happen the same with his coordinator in the management of the European projects awarded to B.N.S., Mr Liviu Voinea, whos was promoted as delegate minister for the budget, position that allowed him to serve the clientele, by setting up a hidden fund of “rainy days money” with the complicity of the IMF, WB and EC – the so-called budget for SR-TD within the MNE budget...

.. Therefore, we have a budget for something that does not exist, which is to receive funding from the Structural Funds for 2014-2020, too, while EC pretends not to see it, starting with the European Commissioner for Research-Innovation. The authors of this can be found at all levels, starting with the Prime Minister, Victor Ponta, the ministers E.O. Teodorovici, Remus Procopie, M.C. Costoiu and the author, of course, the minister delegate Liviu Voinea, and continuing with the responsible factors from the international for a (IMF, WB, and not the last one, the EC), that supervise and monitor the budget. They were also helped by some trade unions federations leaders, such Anton Hadăr, from the F.N. “Alma Mater”.

Anyway, the data INS has supplied on the getting the representativeness for the SR-TD breach the Law 319 /2003 and the recommendations of the Researcher’s European Charter on this professional category – the scientific researcher and the SR-TD staff.
